Established by the late Bertha Agee, these academic scholarships are presented for application to Eastern Kentucky University students with an established and documented Specific Learning Disability in Reading and/or Dyslexia.

Two academic scholarships consisting of \$1000.00 each will be awarded towards the cost of tuition, to each of two students who meet the following criteria. If tuition is paid for by another grant, scholarship or agency, the award will go directly to the student.
