Scholarship Application for Transfer Students

Eastern Kentucky University offers a range of academic scholarships designed to reward scholastic achievement and enhance the University community through the attraction of academically talented students.

The University also awards a number of scholarships funded through private funds administered in the Eastern Kentucky University Foundation. Students need only to complete the enclosed application form to be considered for all scholarships awarded in the University Scholarship Office. Students who receive foundation scholarships will be required to complete a written letter of appreciation to the donor.

Some discipline-specific scholarships are awarded based on selection processes within the appropriate academic department. For additional information please contact the department of your intended major.

In order to be considered for need-based scholarships you must also complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). This application can be obtained online at: www.fafsa.ed.gov. The FAFSA is not required for consideration of the academic scholarships.

The information in the Scholarship Opportunities table is applicable to transfer students enrolling at Eastern Kentucky University for the first time in the fall semester, 2008.

Transfer Presidential Scholarship

ELIGIBILITY: Must have a minimum of a 3.0 college GPA and have completed a minimum of 30 credit hours.

BENEFITS: One-half the cost of in-state tuition for up to six semesters.

CONDITIONS¹: Students must maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA and be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate in order for the scholarship to be renewed.

Dr. Rodney Gross Scholarship

ELIGIBILITY: Must be black U.S. citizen, Kentucky resident and be admitted to EKU with intention of pursuing either an undergraduate or graduate degree; must have 2.5 college GPA with extracurricular support in athletics, community and/or student government services OR a 3.0 GPA without extracurricular activities.

BENEFITS: Awards will range from \$1,000-\$3,000 per year, and will be applied to student's tuition and fees.

CONDITIONS¹: For renewal, students must maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA, enroll full-time, participate in the Academic Monitoring Program in the University Diversity Office and reapply annually.

J.W. Thurman Alumni Scholarship

ELIGIBILITY: Must be the dependent child of an EKU graduate, score at least an ACT composite of 18, and have a minimum of 2.8 GPA in high school. This is competitive based and not all applicants are awarded a scholarship.

BENEFITS: \$500 per semester.

CONDITIONS: Must maintain 2.8 GPA and be enrolled full time for renewal.

¹ A campus/community service component is required for most scholarships.
