# Scholarship Application for Transfer Students

Eastern Kentucky University offers a range of academic scholarships designed to reward scholastic achievement and enhance the University community through the attraction of academically talented students.

The University also awards a number of scholarships funded through private funds administered in the Eastern Kentucky University Foundation. Students need only to complete the enclosed application form to be considered for all scholarships awarded in the University Scholarship Office. Students who receive foundation scholarships will be required to complete a written letter of appreciation to the donor.

Some discipline-specific scholarships are awarded based on selection processes within the appropriate academic department. For additional information please contact the department of your intended major.

In order to be considered for need-based scholarships you must also complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). This application can be obtained online at: [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). The FAFSA is not required for consideration of the academic scholarships.
